- 9:00 am Orientation, Introductions and Team Assignments
The players will meet the celebrity coaches, divide into ten-man teams and get a taste of what's to come.
- 10:00 am Full Tour of Special Ops Paintball and SO Vintage Paintball Gun Collection
Check out the Special Ops Store, Factory and Design facilities while laying your eyes on the largest collection of unique, vintage paintball markers in the world (over 900 legendary markers!)
- 10:30 am X-7 Builder Clinic
Outfit your new, FREE X-7 with the FREE mod kit you have designed on the X-7 Builder.
- 11:30 am Traditional Special Ops Lunch (provided by SO)
Experience the culinary ecstasy of the world famous Mexican lunch truck that fuels the creative power of SO.
- 12:30 pm Camo and Vest Fitting
In groups of ten, the teams will pick up their free custom vests ,Elite camo, and Vforce Grill masks, try them on and gear up to play.

Lay your eyes on the finest private paintball field in the nation.
- 2:15 pm Position Clinics
Jump into your position and hear tips and techniques from some of the greatest paintballers ever to play Dagger, Saber, Broadsword, Hammer, Sniper and Commander. These celebrity players will give your instruction, then put you on the field to run drills and scrimmages in your position of choice.
- 4:15 pm Rest & Refresh
Take a break for some drinks and snacks to tide you over (provided by Special Ops.)
- 5:15 pm SPPL Game Orientation
Get ready to play the monster SPPL game of your young life. Thirty-on-thirty three-flag action on the Special Ops Retribution Field with celebrity commanders. Old buddies and legendary pro players take to the woods to go head-to-head in a historical paintball battle. Greg Hastings and Rocky

Cagnoni face off to lead you and your team in a winner-takes-all three-flag battle under modified SPPL rules.

- 7:30 pm Bar-be-cue Dinner out at the Field
Nate and Timmy hit the bar-be-cue out at the Retribution Field and crank out chicken and ribs for the hordes of starving players.
- 8:30 pm Night Vision Clinic
Night Vision expert Dwayne “Kahuna” Bell gives you the ins-and-outs and night vision equipment in preparation for the night skirmish to come. As Dwayne likes to say, “in the land of the blind, the one-eyed man is king.”
- 9:30 pm Begin Night Vision Skirmishes
Battle it out in darkness for domination of the nighttime paintball battlefield using night vision equipment on loan from LinePair.com and Special Ops Paintball. While you wait for your team’s turn, battle it out with your buddies and Greg Hastings on the PSP playing Greg Hastings Tournament Paintball.

Saturday, June 23, 2007

- 8:00 am Paintball Elite Challenge Orientation
- 8:30 am Move to First Rotations
- 9:00 am Paintball Elite Challenge Rotations Begin
One hour rotations through the action-packed series of Elite Challenges begins, including:
1. Machine Gun Shoot: Take your pick from thirty full-auto machine guns and sniper rifles pulled from the arsenals of the greatest militaries of all time. Get your hands on the H&K MP-5, UMP, G3, Colt AR-15, Mac 10, Uzi, Thompson SubMachine Gun, AK-47, FN-FAL, Sten Gun, FN 249 SAW, H&K PSG1, Barrett 82A1, Dragunov Sniper Rifle and the M60 SAW. Rip of a mag of the machine gun or sniper rifle of your dreams on Special Ops’ private, mountain shooting range.
 2. Downed Pilot Mission: Master the use of map, compass, GPS and field orienteering as you and your team of ten fights to recover a pilot downed behind enemy lines. Return the pilot to the safe zone in competition with other teams to

score high marks for winning this scenario (played against seasoned Special Ops Factory Team players) within record time.

3. Tiberius Pistol Competition: Led by Tac 8 inventor Tyler Tiberius, compete against your team for the honor of “Top Gun” on the run-through pistol course. Best score and time will earn you a free Tiberius Tac 8, the greatest paintball pistol ever made.
4. Elite Team Obstacle Course: Cruise through a series of hard-charging, high-wire challenges in competition with the other teams to score highest marks and win prizes. End your run through the course with a ripping ride on a hair-raising five hundred foot zip line that crosses a hundred foot chasm.
5. LRRP/Sniper Mission: Hone your sniper skills against a crack team of Special Ops Factory players as they struggle to protect their Commander against you and your team. After half your team has been issued and trained on loaner Longbow or Q-Bow Sniper Markers (the other half will carry their X-7s in support of the designated snipers,) you’ll plunge into the forest to find the enemy base camp and take out the Commander with precision fire. Again, your team will be scored against the other teams to establish the top snipers of the week.
6. Stronghold Assault Mission: Get professional coaching on the use of comms and hand signals as the Special Ops Team sends you and your crew out using the best field comms available. Conduct a coordinated assault on a fixed, stronghold position using your new comm skills to sync a finely choreographed attack to take out a corps of determined defenders. Your speed and effectiveness will determine your score against all other teams.

Big Dan from Special Ops will fire up the grill again to bury you in hot dogs and hamburgers. The Grub is definitely ON!
- 6:30 pm Conclude Elite Challenge and Return to Hotel
Clean up and get ready for the monster player party.
- 8:30 pm Players Party Begins
Party with the Big Dogs of Paintball! Come together at the home of Jayson “JOracle” Orvis to tell stories (and lies) about the huge day of paintball. Groove to the funky sounds of Dewey and the Decibel System as they play their greatest hits such as “This is How We Rock the Woods,” “Recon Riot” and “Woodsball Town in a Tourney World.” Grub on gourmet pizza, jam on video games (GHTP and other networked computer games,) watch action movies in the theater and receive the prizes you and your team earned during the Elite Challenge.

Sunday, June 24, 2007

Sleep in a little, then launch ourselves out of bed for the final, grand finale of the weekend.

- 11:15 am Breakfast at Bauer
Big Dan and the sales team cook up a hearty brunch out at the ole Ghost Town.
- 11:30 am Grand Finale, Ultimate Game Orientation
- 11:45 am Special “Weapons,” Special Missions Orientation
Mortar crews, Tank crews, RPG teams, Smoke throwers, Helo gunners, Tower gunners, Mine layers and Field Commanders all get together to be briefed on their equipment and special rules.
- 12:30 pm Ultimate Paintball Game ON!!
Under the watchful eye of Grand Marshall Dwayne Convirs (Organizer of Oklahoma D-Day) the Ultimate Game takes off with mixed missions and tons of special paintball ordnance. Two teams of fifty clash to determine who will walk away with the bragging rights of the Ultimate Elite Paintball Team. With Helicopter insertions, paintball tanks, rockets, mortars, smoke, mines, machine “gun” towers and interesting missions, the two teams will vie for domination while chasing points for missions successfully completed. Good command structure and crack communications will make all the difference in this all-out battle of the paintball greats!

Last prizes handed out to MVP and Sportsmanship winners for the day and the entire weekend. Two MVP/Sportsmanship grand prizes will be awarded which will include all-expense-paid return trips and tuition to the next Elite Weekend to serve as instructors (kind of like in the movie “Top Gun.”)
